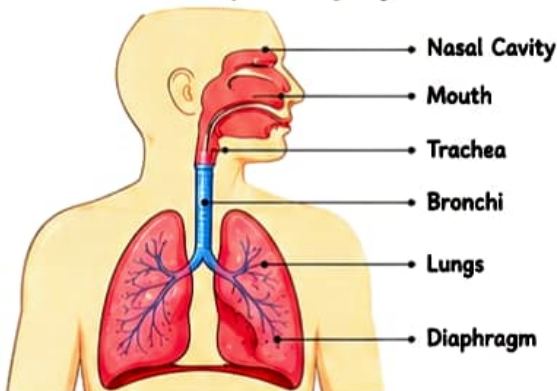

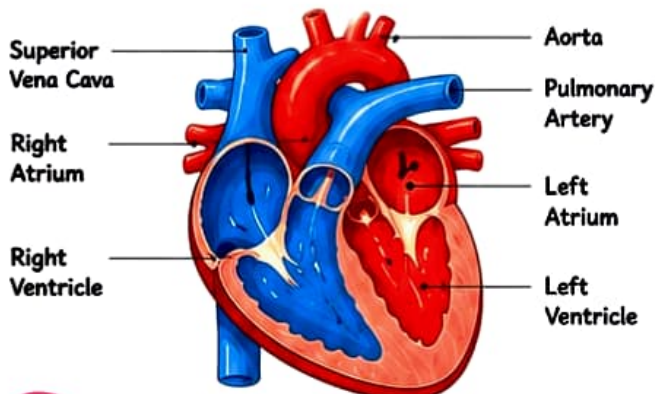

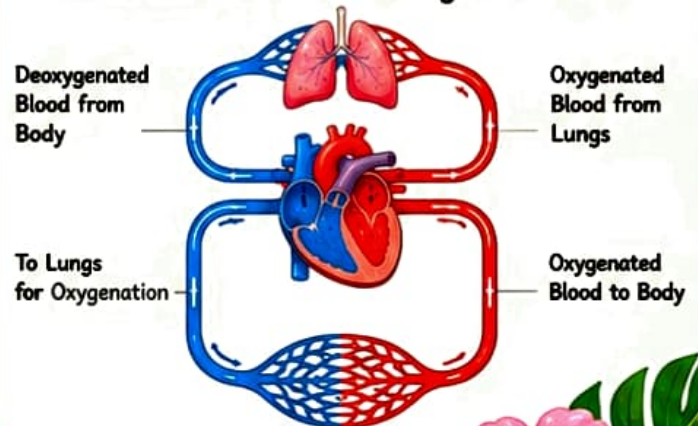

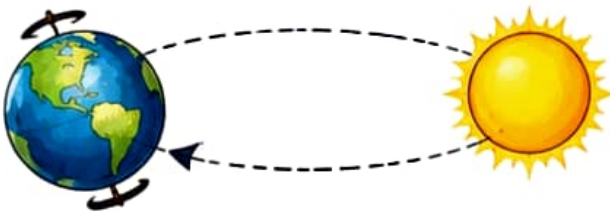

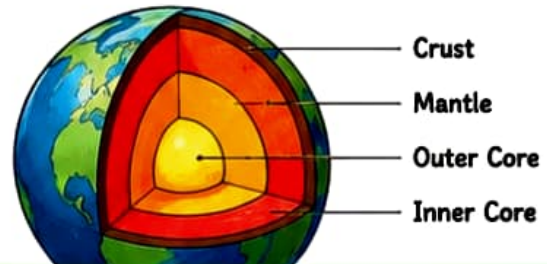

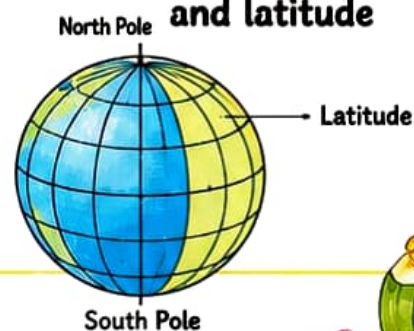

RED HOUSE

WORM MALWARE ATTACK



- A worm is a type of malware.
- It self-replicates to spread to other computers.
- It can slow down or crash the system.
- Examples: Conficker, ILOVEYOU, Mydoom.



Tip: Keep your system updated and use antivirus.

BLUE HOUSE

SPYWARE MALWARE ATTACK



- Spyware secretly collects information about the user.
- It tracks your activities and sends data to attackers.
- It can steal passwords, personal info and more.
- Examples: CoolWebSearch, WebHancer.



Tip: Don't download unknown programs and always use a firewall.

GREEN HOUSE

TROJAN MALWARE ATTACK



- A Trojan looks like a legitimate program but is harmful.
- It creates a backdoor for hackers to access your system.
- It steals data or damages files.
- Examples: Zeus, Emotet, RAT (Remote Access Trojan).



Tip: Don't open attachments or files from unknown senders.

YELLOW HOUSE

KEYLOGGER MALWARE



- A keylogger records keystrokes secretly.
- It can capture passwords, messages and other important data.
- It sends the recorded data to hackers.
- Examples: Ardamax Keylogger, Kidlogger.



Tip: Use strong passwords and enable 2-step verification.

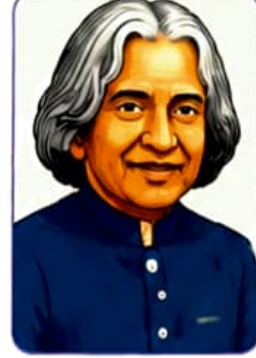
