- c) Add a favourite line from the poem in your artwork.
- d) Write a short -explanation (3-4 lines) of your illustrations.

2. Choose one of the following formats:

- 3D Model: A creative representation (e.g., a calm nature scene, Tagore's Ashram in Shantiniketan, a brain-heart connection model with his quotes).

3. Include the following elements:

- Definition of Mindfulness
- Importance of Mindfulness for students and everyday life.
- Tagore's connection to Mindfulness:
- How he believed in living in harmony with nature.
- How his poetry focused on the present moment, emotions, and nature's rhythm.
- His Shantiniketan school promoting holistic, mindful education.
- A visual or drawing (e.g., a calm mind, nature scene, or Tagore in a meditative pose).
- Your own reflection (2–3 lines) on what you learned about mindfulness from Tagore.

4. Be creative:

Use colours, symbols, leaves, string art, calligraphy for quotes, etc., to express the calm and awareness that mindfulness brings.
